Course Design

The design of the course has been, and will continue to be, determined through the close, collaborative working relationship between the University of Suffolk, Practice Partners and Service Users. The purpose of the programme is to support the development of the student in order to meet the requirements for registration with the NMC as an Adult Nurse.

This course will provide the knowledge, attitude and skills essential to register as an Adult Nurse. Nursing is a continually evolving profession, so a key part of the course is about developing the skills to adapt to new situations and ensure the student becomes a resilient practitioner.
